A Year of Accomplishments!

This year has been a busy and productive one for Moody Family Housing! Here's a look at some of the major projects we've completed:

- 17 Full roof replacements.
- 27 Full gutter replacements.
- Completion of the Sewer Line Project.
- Replacement of 3 gazebo roofs, along with painting, installing benches, and adding lights to 5 bus stops/shelters.
- Community beautification: Our staff planted flowers, added two small trees, and installed benches under the gazebos in Quiet Pines to give back to the community.

In addition to these projects, we've been hard at work maintaining our homes:

- Responded to 2,870 work orders (through October 10).
- Completed 187 preventative maintenance tasks.

We're proud of what we've accomplished this year, and we're excited for what's to come. 2026 will bring even more projects! Stay tuned to hear about what's next!



MAINTENANCE TIPS

Get Your Home Winter Ready: Heating System Tips!

As we approach the cooler months, it's time to prepare your heating system for the season. Here's what to expect and how to stay safe:

What's Normal?

- A brief burning or smoky smell when you first turn on the heat. This is dust burning off the heating elements after months of non-use.
- Smoke alarms may sound once or twice during the first run.
- The smell should fade within 10 to 15 minutes.

What's NOT Normal?

If you notice any of these issues, turn off your system immediately and contact maintenance.

- The smell does not go away after 10 to 15 minutes.
- Visible smoke is coming from vents.
- Alarms continue to sound, or you feel lightheaded.



How your Heating System Works!

GAS HEAT:

- Uses a burner with a flame to heat air.
- A fan pushes the warm air through ducts into your home.
- A small "burning dust" smell is normal after months of non-use.

ELECTRIC HEAT:

- Uses electric coils (similar to a toaster) to heat air.
- A fan circulates the warm air.
- You may notice a faint warm metal or dusty smell the first time you turn it on.

Quick Resident Officerist
Turn on your heat for 10 to 15 minutes this week to test it.
Ensure warm air is coming from the vents.
Check that smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are working.
Report any issues or unusual odors immediately.

Testing your heat early ensures everyone stays safe, warm, and ready for winter.
