

Important UA Program Announcement: Billing Is Live

- We are officially utilizing live billing. **USAGE IS NOW LIVE UNDER THE AIR FORCE UA PROGRAM.** The next bill you will be responsible to act on will be in January 2026 for your December 2025 usage. Those who use less than the baseline are eligible for a rebate when the balance exceeds \$50 or more, while those who exceed the baseline will be responsible for overages when the balance exceeds the \$50 threshold.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

Locating And Operating Water Shut-Off Valves

Knowing how and where to shut off your toilet or sink water supply is important in times of emergencies:

- **Toilets:** Toilets have a single cold-water valve, called a "stop valve." Turn the handle clockwise to shut off the water if your toilet is overflowing.
- **Sinks:** Look for the valve under the sink, usually at the back of the cabinet, they are connected to the water supply tubes that serve the faucet. One for hot, one for cold, usually with the cold on the right-hand side. Turn the valve(s) clockwise to turn off the water.
- Water Shut-Off Valves: The Quiet Pines laundry room main shut-off valve (which shuts the whole home off) is in a small hatch door above the washer-dryer connections. For Magnolia Grove, it is outside in front of the home in a box on the ground.
